

PostgreSQL - Dumping Data

Windows

```
cd "\Program Files\PostgreSQL\9.3\bin"  
pg_dumpall -Upostgres > \usr\tomcat\webapps\da\WEB-INF\data\data.bu
```

Linux

```
su - postgres  
pg_dumpall > /usr/tomcat/webapps/da/WEB-INF/data/data.bu
```

PostgreSQL - Restoring Data

Since you are restoring the whole database you will need to delete the database completely. So please remember to do a back up before you do so. Also, you must stop tomcat.

Windows

```
cd "\Program Files\PostgreSQL\9.3\bin"  
psql -Upostgres  
drop database da;  
\q  
psql -Upostgres < \usr\tomcat\webapps\da\WEB-INF\data\data.bu
```

Linux

```
su - postgres  
psql  
drop database da;  
\q  
psql < /usr/tomcat/webapps/da/WEB-INF/data/data.bu
```

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
