

PostgreSQL - Dumping Data

Windows

```
cd "\\Program Files\\PostgreSQL\\9.3\\bin"  
pg_dumpall -Upostgres > data.bu
```

Linux

```
su - postgres  
pg_dumpall > data.bu  
zip data.zip data.bu  
exit
```

The above will save the data in the folder /var/lib/pgsql

PostgreSQL - Restoring Data

Since you are restoring the whole database you will need to delete the database completely. So please remember to do a back up before you do so. Also, **you must stop tomcat**.

Windows

```
cd "\\Program Files\\PostgreSQL\\9.3\\bin"  
psql -Upostgres  
drop database da;  
\q  
unzip data.zip  
psql -Upostgres < data.bu
```

Linux

```
su - postgres  
psql  
drop database da;  
\q  
psql < data.bu  
exit
```

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
